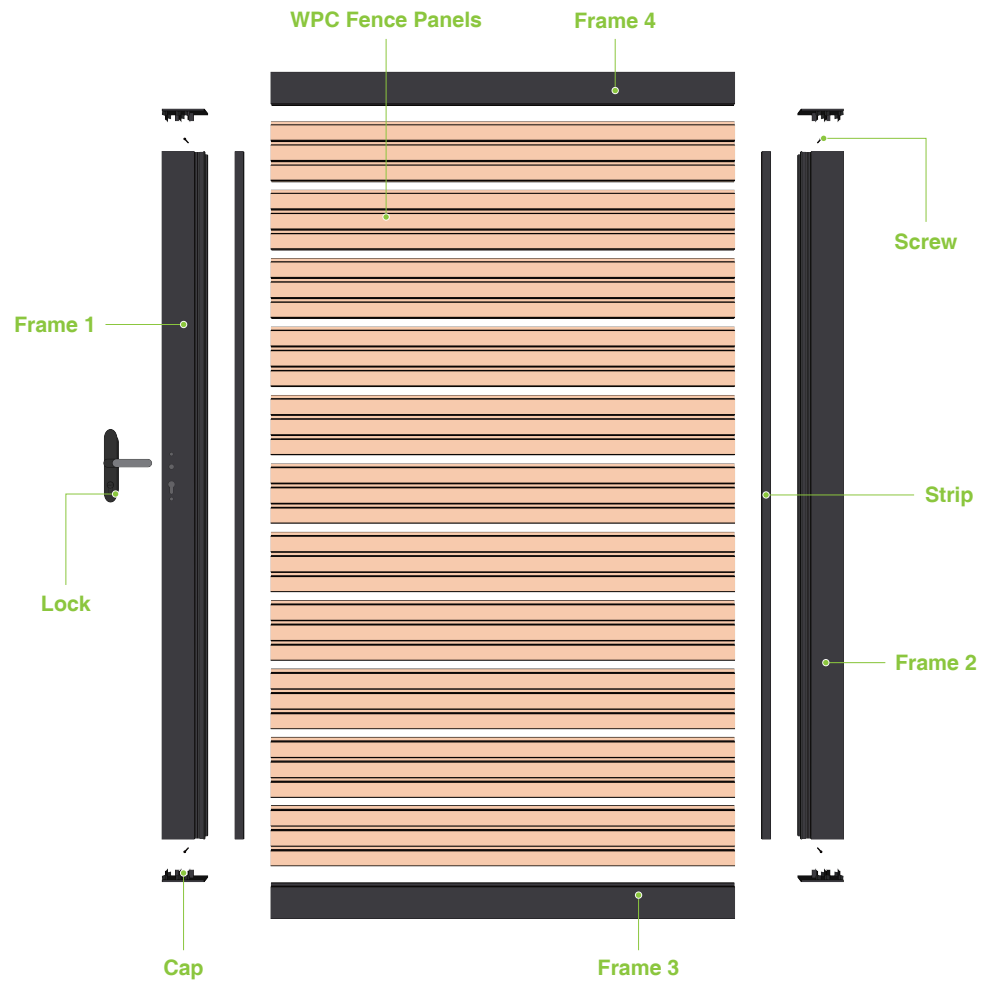


# WPC Fence Gate

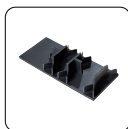

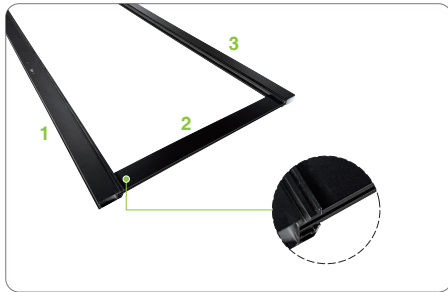

# Installation Steps



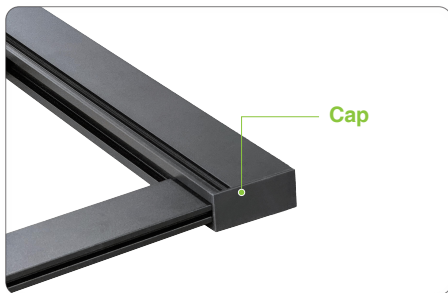
## 1. Connect Frames 1, 2, and 3

Frame 3 functions as the bottom frame. Pay attention to the installation orientation the installation orientation: the grooved side should face downward.



## 2. Install the Screws

First, pre-drill holes of the appropriate depth in the frames. Use these pre-drilled holes to secure the frames with screws to avoid damage.



## 3. Install the Bottom Cap

The cap is used to secure the strips that will be installed later, holding them in place and preventing them from shifting.



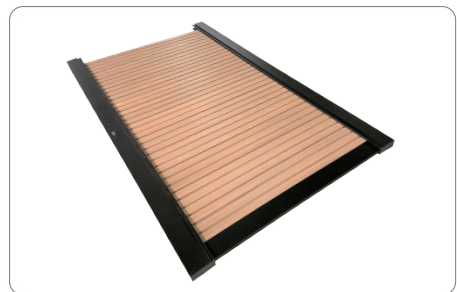
## 4. Install the first WPC fence panel

Insert the panel from the top. Once it is firmly in place, you can fasten it with screws immediately, or wait until all panels are installed before securing them uniformly.



## 5. Install the remaining WPC fence panels

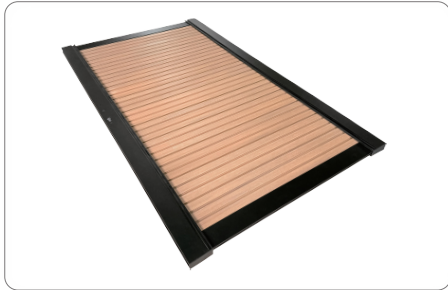
Insert the remaining fence panels one by one until they are securely in place, ensuring they fit tightly together.



## 6. Install the final fence panel

When installing the last panel, if it is longer than the frame, trim it to the correct size before installation.

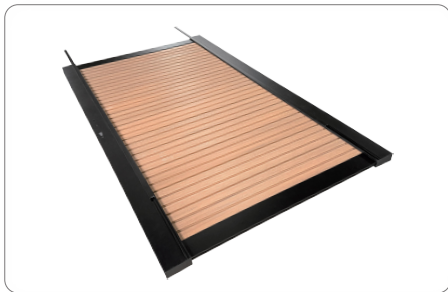
## 7. Install Frame 4

Frame 4 serves as the top frame; secure it by driving in screws.



## 8. Secure the Fence Panels with Screws

Secure each fence panel with at least two screws to ensure stability.



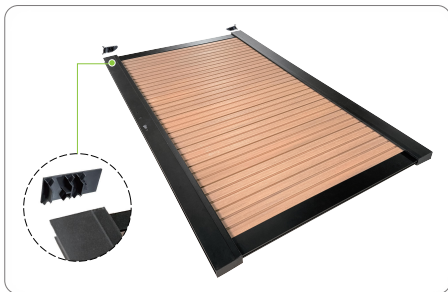
## 9. Insert the Cover Strips

The cover strips are designed to conceal the screws, creating a clean and attractive finish for the fence gate.



## 10. Cover Strip Details

The cover strip fits seamlessly with the frame, acting as a design highlight of this gate.



## 11. Install the Top Cap

This top cap secures the position of the trim and the fence gate frame.



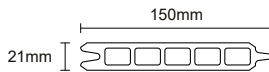
## 12. Install the Door Lock

The door lock handle should face inward; press the handle downward to open the door.

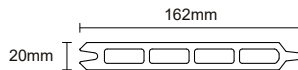


## Classic WPC Fence
